#### Erasmus+

The number of our Erasmus-partners is above 110.

We offer the Comparative Law Programme for incoming Erasmus students.

The Programme aims to facilitate a fruitful academic experience in Szeged for visiting students from abroad by offering them the opportunity of obtaining a certificate after completing courses selected from a wide range of options.

Courses offered in the framework of the Programme are taught in English, French or German by our University staff as well as French, German, British and American visiting professors. The Programme consists of compulsory and optional courses.

A certificate will be awarded to those who obtain the required 30 credit points by completing at least two compulsory and three optional courses.
