

## About the Faculty

Our long history started with the foundation of our predecessor, the Faculty of Science and Mathematics in 1921 when the University of Kolozsvár moved to Szeged.

Teaching and research activities are divided between the institutes and departments within the Faculty. We have seven institutes, each of which can be regarded as a partially independent teaching and research unit:

- Institute of Biology
- Institute of Chemistry
- Institute of Institute of Environmental Science and Technology
- Institute of Geography and Geology
- Institute of Informatics
- Bolyai Institute / Institute of Mathematics
- Institute of Physics

There are 7 Doctoral Schools these are Biology, Chemistry, Computer Science, Geosciences, Environmental Sciences, Mathematics and Physics.
