## Information on the conduct of the Dean's exceptional examination permissions in the second semester of the academic year 2022/2023

As per the Academic and Examination Regulations of the University of Szeged (SZTE TVSZ 12.1), "[o]ther examinations outside the examination period (not the preferential study and examination timetable) may be authorised by the head of the faculty, exceptionally, in particular fairness, on a case-by-case basis, and upon request."

According to the above and taking section 10.3 of the Faculty Academic Regulations of the Albert Szent-Györgyi Medical School into consideration, students have an opportunity to be given one single exceptional examination permission made available by the Dean between July 10 and July 13, 2023 provided that they satisfy the conditions that follow.

A student is entitled to request to be granted one examination permission in a single compulsory subject in the period above that s/he did not manage to pass in the current second semester of the 2022/2023 academic year. Supporting documentation is not required.

In accordance with 14.2 of the Academic and Examination Regulations of the University of Szeged, students can also make use of this one exceptional examination permission in the form of taking a fourth examination in a subject in the above period provided that they have passed every other compulsory subject in the current semester: "A failed examination in the same subject may be retaken twice in the same examination period, with the addition that a student whose only course taken but not completed in the examination period in question may take a third remedial examination."

In case the student exhausted the maximum number of examination chances in the subject concerned (six), no further examination chances can be granted.

## **<u>Reasons disqualifying students</u>** from being given a permission:

- having had an unjustified absence in an examination in the subject in question in the second semester of the academic year 2022/2023
- not having failed an examination in the subject in question at least once in the second semester of the academic year 2022/2023
- having exhausted the three Dean's exceptional permissions available to students
- having had an unjustified absence from an exceptional examination formerly granted by the Dean, which also entirely disqualifies the student from being given any further exceptional permissions
- > aiming to improve a successful examination in this period
- having been given a Dean's Warning or having been sanctioned by the Student Disciplinary Committee of the University of Szeged in the second semester of the academic year 2022/2023
- Requests are to be submitted through <u>MODULO</u> exclusively between June 29, 2023 (Thursday), 8:00 and <u>July 3, 2023 (Monday), 12:00 (midday)</u>. Sitting for an exceptional examination does not exempt students from attending summer practice sessions.
- Replies to requests will be announced in MODULO by July 5, 2023. Formal replies on paper will not be issued.
- The departments involved will receive the list of students eligible to take an examination on July 6, 2023. Only students on the list will be permitted to sit for an examination.
