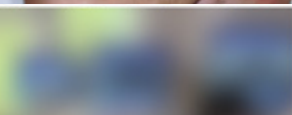

About the Faculty

The dental education in Szeged goes back as far as 1926, when the first university office was established. Since 2007 it is considered as the independent Faculty of Dentistry. The Dental School in Szeged is an outstanding centre for education, scientific work and patient care, located in the heart of the city. Meanwhile it became a regional centre for dental and maxillofacial care in the south-eastern region of Hungary. The Faculty of Dentistry of the University of Szeged was the first in Hungary to introduce a new, EU-compatible educational program from the academic year 2013/2014, in order to harmonize the curriculum with the European standards of training dental education.

The five-year program is designed to combine the basic and clinical sciences. In the first two years students are taught sciences – medical and dental courses – which are the foundation of clinical dentistry. From the third year, more emphasis is placed on the study of dental diseases and their treatment. The last two years serve the intensive clinical study of the various disciplines of dentistry. After a successful completion of the program students are awarded the title Doctor Medicinae Dentaire (dentist; DMD)

Available Programmes for International Students

Dentistry (DMD) in English (10 semesters)

It is an undivided five-year program designed in a modular fashion. The EU-compatible educational program from the academic year 2013/14, is a practice-centred programme, where the ratio of practical courses is about 65% of the whole curriculum. Practice involves manual training, patient assessment and management, and a 2-year clinical module where students treat real patients.

Application Requirements in General

Applicants need to apply online: it is required to submit the application form, to pay the application and entrance exam fees and upload the necessary documents.

- Applicants are required to be over the age of 18 in the year of application.
- Applications are accepted from graduates of accredited high schools or colleges/universities.
- Applicants are required to sit for an entrance examination. (Biology, Chemistry or Physics and English language).
- The applicants are allowed to participate in a maximum of two examinations during one application period if the chance is offered by the University of Szeged
- According to the decision of the Admission Committee of the Faculty of Dentistry of the University of Szeged, students who have failed any subject in their final year of their high school studies are not entitled to apply to our programs.
- Students who have successfully pursued dental medicine studies in English language at other accredited universities can apply for admission without being obliged to take an entrance examination.

Services of the Faculty for International Students:

Aside from attending lectures and laboratory classes, time outside the classroom offers a wide range of exciting events for the students. Dental students are famous for their solidarity and jointly organized programs. Student residence is provided to those international students who hold a governmental scholarship, such as the Stipedium Hungaricum. These dormitories also provide facilities for sports, cultural and other social events. Those who rent an apartment may use the online university database or the Facebook page for apartments to rent.
