Applicants need to apply online: it is required to submit the application form, to pay the application and entrance exam fees and upload the necessary documents.

- For the Classical Musical Instrumental Performance (MA) and Classical Singing (MA) program: BA degree in performance/musicology, a demonstrated proficiency in English (B2/Intermediate), and online entrance exam.
