APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Submitted online application, Secondary school certificate, a proficiency in English demonstrated at the entrance examination or proved with a language examination certificate (B2 level or equivalent: TOEFL RBT, TOEFL CBT, IELTS). A written entrance examination and a motivational interview.
